



Give a gift that helps families facing poverty grow food and earn an income.

Papayas, bananas, guavas ... in Rajasthan, northern India, where more than half of families live below the poverty line, Tearfund's partner EFICOR has been training farmers in soil and water conservation, kitchen gardening and sustainable agriculture. Now their crops are thriving and they can not only feed and nourish their own families, but also generate an income.

"This organisation has made us capable enough so that now we do not have to buy anything from outside and on the contrary, we can go to the market and sell our cultivated fruit, vegetables and grains," says Ramlal, whose family is now enjoying delicious, healthy, home-grown food. learning and livelihoods.



Empower a family with a new source of nutrition and income: a goat! As well as providing milk and manure fertiliser, goats can be bred and passed on to other families, sharing the benefits throughout the community.



For families facing poverty, putting food on the table can be a daily challenge. Help provide training and supplies for a family to raise chickens, giving them nutritious eggs to eat and a source of income too.



A flourishing vegie patch doesn't happen by accident – this gift ensures that the right tools are available to get that garden growing! With training, seeds and tools, a vegie patch can feed a family – and beyond!



Food insecurity is a huge challenge for communities facing poverty. Help farmers to thrive with training, resources and support to sustainably grow nutritious food for themselves and their communities.






Clean water isn't always within reach. Many communities facing poverty rely on unsafe, contaminated or distant water sources. This gift helps people access life-giving clean water and reduce preventable diseases.

Give a gift that helps provide safe water and sanitation education in marginalised communities.

Five years ago, preventable diseases were rampant in Mayel's (pictured, name changed) village in the Central Highlands of Afghanistan. Many of them could be traced back to an old well that was the only source of water for her village. But today, the community is experiencing renewed health and vitality.

Tearfund's local partner worked with community members to build a new, clean water source and composting latrines, and gave memorable lessons about health and hygiene. Free from recurrent illness, children and adults alike are now strong and able to enjoy community life, learning and livelihoods.



Disease can spread easily when basic hygiene supplies are lacking. But the practice of effective hand washing can stop a disease in its tracks! Help communities stay healthy with a hand washing station and hygiene education.



Not only do toilets improve hygiene, they provide safety, dignity and better health outcomes for everyone. Whether a school toilet block or a household latrine, this gift helps lead to healthier, empowered communities.



When a reliable source of water isn't available, health and livelihoods are held back. A safe and sustainable source of water, and the training and resources to maintain it, can make all the difference for an entire village.





The coronavirus pandemic has challenged the people of the world in ways that we couldn't have previously imagined. This gift supports Tearfund partners who are working tirelessly to bring practical help and powerful hope to people in some of the most vulnerable communities in the world.

In India, which has seen the devastating impacts of coronavirus, the grief of losing loved ones has been compounded by job losses, food insecurity and economic hardship. Tearfund's partner EFICOR has been working to help as many needy people as possible through financial support, distribution of masks and soap, and cash for work in rural areas.



Many children around the world suffer from diseases that are preventable and treatable. This gift provides children and families with access to effective health care and nutrition and hygiene education to keep them strong.

Supporting training in culturally appropriate techniques to strengthen relationships, this gift will equip these leaders to be better able to support people to live in healthy families and stronger communities.



Give a gift that helps people get a basic education and the opportunity to improve their knowledge and skills.


With the support of a confident and equipped teacher like Bereket (pictured far left), young students in rural Ethiopia have bright futures ahead!
